

LOCAL RULES valid from 1 JUNE 2025

*Out of bounds is defined by white stakes, and the fence around the driving range.

The boundary line of out of bounds, is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts. Stakes and posts itself are out of bounds.

*A ball coming to rest on or beyond the public road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes (Hole 9,10,14,16).

*The red penalty area behind hole 15 defined on only one side extends to infinity.

If a ball is in the penalty area behind hole 15, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

Take relief under Rule 17.1

or, as an extra option,

Drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone behind the bunker of hole 15. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3

*At the player's option, dung from birds may be treated either as:

A loose impediment that may be removed under Rule 15.1

or

Ground under repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1

*Wild flower areas are marked by stakes with a green head.

This is a no play zone. You MUST avoid these under rule 16.1 f

*Sprinkler head in your line of play, near the green.

You have a free relief if a sprinkler head is located within two club-lengths of the edge of the putting green, and within two club-lengths of your ball.

Your line of play must be a reasonable line.

*Robotic mowers are considered as an outside agency.

If your ball is moved while in motion, and changed from direction by a mower, you must play the ball as it lies under rule 11.1b.

If your ball was stationary, and then deflected by a mower, you must replace the ball to its original position. See rule 9.6 and rule 14.2
